Future Prospects

China enjoys rapid economic development. Taiwan has to exchange with Mainland China and other countries as frequently as possible. Both the public and private sectors are in desperate need of excellent graduate students with training in national development and Mainland China studies. The courses offered by the institute are closely linked to national and industrial development that is the best choice for students to continue their advanced study. Among our Ph.D. graduates in the years between 2013 and 2016, 26% work in the educational field and 25% serve in public offices. We have made a great contribution to national development. Among the Masters graduates, 10% work in public offices, 20% work in education, and 30% work in private corporations. Our master program curriculum matches the needs of the society. Our graduates are suitable to go into education, public offices, research, and private corporations. Students can choose to work inside the country or go overseas.
